Members in Person: Mayor Joe Grandy, Commissioners Bryan Davenport, Harris Darby – City of Kingsport, Travis Olinger and Benji Whitehead – City of Johnson City, Glenn Rosenoff and Kevin Brobeck – Town of Jonesborough, Jim Hilborn, Ken Rea, Christina Wichlin and Lance Lowery-FTDD, Charlie Baines, Patrick Ryan, Sherry Greene

Called to order by Chairman Davenport.

Items Discussed:

Harris Darby, City of Kingsport, stated they are finishing up design work on the four Kingsport projects (Deakins Road, Double Springs Road, Link Road and Hunt Road). Estimated costs are under budget. Budget is approaching \$2 million and should go out to bid by September. Funding will come through ARPA funds. Kingsport will work with the County Highway Department regarding purchase of ROW's on Deakins Road, Double Springs Road and Link Road.

Benji Whitehead, City of Johnson City, informed the Task Force that 90% of the design work was complete for proposed projects including Grassy Valley, Bill Bennett Road, Hartmantown Road and Pleasant Valley Road. Bids will go out mid-August and bid opening should be in September. Proposed projects are estimated to be \$2.7 million. Obtaining materials is the largest concern at this time.

Kevin Brobeck, Town of Jonesborough, informed the Task Force that Jonesborough is working on their 5th water project. By January 2023, Jonesborough hopes to have 20,000 feet of new waterline in the ground. Largest concern at this time is having workers to complete the projects.

Chairman Davenport stated the County Commission had appropriated \$12.5 million of ARPA funds for waterline installation. To date \$1.5 million has been expended. There is a definite need for more projects.

Mayor Grandy spoke of TDEC grant funds that will be coming available. Ken Rea, FTDD, will lead the administration of application for these funds. Mayor Grandy stated there will need to be \$7 million worth of waterline projects to expend the County's TDEC funds. Projects using these funds must be bid by December 2024 and complete by December 2026. Ken Rea stated applications are due by November 1st, 2022 and a resolution may be required from the County. Also required will be a list of projects, costs, maps and reason for the project.

Charlie Baines spoke on the need of a fire hydrant at the Nolichucky Valley Volunteer Fire Department, 133 Mathes Circle. Kevin Brobeck will bring a cost estimate from the Town of Jonesborough to the next meeting.

With no further business meeting was adjourned.

Petition for public water


