RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2018-2019 RE: LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPLIES

WHEREAS, the Washington County Sheriff's Office requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year Budget 2018-2019:

1. Reduce \$25,000.00 from equity line item 101-34525-000-821 (Restricted for Public Safety);
2. Add \$25,000.00 to expense line item 101-54255-431 (Work Release – Law Enforcement Supplies); and

WHEREAS, these amendments are requested to provide funds for supplies and materials for the Washington County Detention Center and represent \$25,000.00 in new spending; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee, at its December 5, 2018, meeting, recommended consideration and approval of the request to the Board of Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fiscal Year Budget 2018-2019 is amended to:

1. Reduce \$25,000.00 from equity line item 101-34525-000-821 (Restricted for Public Safety).
2. Add \$25,000.00 to expense line item 101-54255-431 (Work Release – Law Enforcement Supplies).

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date on which it is approved by the County Mayor or as indicated by certification of the County Clerk, as hereinafter set forth.


