

## WC 101 Program Application for 2025

**All applicants must be 18 or older and residents of Washington County. All applicants are subject to verification and a background check by the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Applications must be submitted by Thursday, August 14, 2025. Preference will be given to one applicant from each of the 15 Washington County districts and 5 other "at large" applicants. The course is limited to 20 participants.\***

WC 101 Program is designed as an overview of county services in order to develop citizen awareness and understanding of the government's role in the community. The objective is to provide residents with the information and background necessary to work together for the enhancement of our community.

The program consists of 4 nights of government information to include presentations, demonstrations, tours, and question-and-answer periods. Each class will meet from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. for four, consecutive Tuesdays from September 23 - October 14. Certificates of completion will be presented at the October 27 County Commission meeting.

Citizens applying for WC101 should be 18 years of age or older; have no criminal record (other than minor traffic violations); commit to attendance of most classes; and sign all required releases, waivers, and agreement forms. Applicants agree that a background check will be conducted to verify all information.

Classes are limited to 20 participants per session. Participants are asked to be on time, as it is necessary to start promptly in order to cover all the scheduled material. Dress is casual, and comfortable footwear is recommended.
